IHSAA Issues – Steve Cotherman – The IATCCC and ICGSA presented 3 proposals to the IIAAA on November 14. The proposals were moving the cross country tournament to 5 semi-states, awarding 25 individual medals at cross country state, and returning to a 4-week tournament in cross country. The votes from the IIAAA were not favorable. We will present again to the IHSAA Board on December 14.
